2. To consider planning and tree works applications received/considered since the last meeting**2.1 S/1032/06/F Paget-Wilkes, 99 High Street – Garden Shed Extension (part retrospective)**

Cllrs Holme and Holroyd withdrew from the meeting. There was a consensus that the two remaining members recommended approval as there was no adverse impact on the surrounding area. In accordance with Standing orders the Clerk will respond on the Council's behalf.

2.2 S/0899/06/F Snook, 7 Thompsons Meadow – extension and conservatory

Recommended for approval as there is no adverse impact upon surrounding development.

2.3 S/0687/06/F 42 Dubbs Knoll Road – extension (retrospective) – amendment

Recommended for approval The Parish Council had no objection to the amended planning permission application. However, it is aware that there are still unresolved issues concerning party wall agreements and building /boundary/access issues which it would be prudent to resolve before the South Cambridgeshire District Council considered their decision.
