1 To receive apologies for absence and declarations of interest

Apologies were received from Cllr J Holroyd and Cllr Mrs D Mitchell.
No declarations of interest were received.

2 To consider planning applications received since the last meeting

2.1 Gypsy and Traveller Development Plan consultation.

The Parish Council believed that the consultation did not affect Guilden Morden, and that Cllr Holroyd's previous notes were still applicable. It was agreed to respond accordingly and to request that the Parish Council be informed of any developments.

2.2 S/2029/08/F - Burns Barn 5, Cold Harbour Farm - Extension and alterations

The meeting was closed for five minutes to allow the applicant and her architect to inform the council of their planning application.

The meeting was re-opened and the proposal was discussed in some detail. It was noted that the area had ceased to be an agricultural site, and that the application would only enhance the area. There were no comments from neighbours. On a proposal by Cllr Freeman, seconded by Cllr Dr Townsend-Stojic, it was unanimously agreed to approve the application.

2.3 S/1683/08/F - 26 Ashwell Road – Dormer Windows in Rear Elevation

It was noted that the application had been approved.
