


**GULDEN MORDEN PARISH COUNCIL**

**Minutes of the Meeting of the Parish Council meeting held in the Village Hall  
on Monday 15 February 2010 at 7.30 pm.**

Present: Cllrs: A Hoad, B Holme (Chairman), J Holroyd, D Mitchell, T Oakes, J Townsend-Stojic and T Bartlett.

1. **To receive apologies for absence and declarations of interest**  
Apologies were received from Cllr Davis (out of parish). There were no declarations of interest.
2. **Matters arising from the last or previous meeting carried forward for discussion/decision**  
None.
3. **To consider planning and tree works applications and decision notices received since the last meeting**
  - 3.1 **Planning Applications received since the last meeting**
    - 3.1.1 **S/0146/10/F – 4 Fox Hill – Variation of Condition 2 of Planning Permission S/0986/95/F to allow for the conversion of garage to children’s playroom**  
Approved unanimously <sup>(Prop TB, 2nd TO)</sup> as there would be no change to the street scene and parking was still available for two cars.
    - 3.1.2 **Tree works 2 High Street**  
The Parish Council recommended that the present application be refused because of the significant impact of the removal of so many trees on the street scene and the lack of a plan for their replacement. It was recommended that a site meeting be arranged between the SCDC trees officer, the owners of 2 High Street and members available. Cllr Townsend-Stojic is to make arrangements for the meeting.
  - 3.3 **Decision Notices**
    - 3.3.1 **S/1527/09/F – 57 High Street – Oil Storage Tank (Retrospective) – Approved by SCDC.**

    - 3.3.2 **S/1345/09/LB – The Mews, Odsey Grange – Alterations for single storey kitchen/dining room extension – Refused by SCDC.**  
Noted.
4. **Central Bedfordshire Council Site Allocations Development Plan Document (DPD) Consultation**  
The Parish Council expressed concern about future developments in Central Bedfordshire having an impact on nearby villages and the existing infrastructure with increased levels of through traffic. The Parish Council wishes to be kept informed of further developments.
