Many years ago the Village voted to keep the Red Telephone Boxes in Guilden Morden and not change to the modern boxes as proposed by British Telecom.

More recently the Parish Council was asked by BT if they would purchase the 2 boxes in the village and for the vast sum of £ 1.00/box, this was agreed, provided the broken panes were replaced. So now the village is the proud owner of two ex Telephone Boxes.

*Your Parish Council asked for ideas to transfer these boxes into useful assets for the village. Ideas of a “Book Exchange”, “Defibrillator Point”, “Art Gallery”, “Information Centre” were put forward as suitable uses. After much discussion it was decided that the “**Book Exchange**” would be in Church Street and an “**Information Centre**” would be at High Street/Ashwell Road. These are now in place and “**Open for Business**”.*
