Due to the urgency of this purchase, a guarantor has stepped in to allow its purchase by the Woodland Trust, and we are glad to say that the purchase is going through. This will double the current area of the existing community woodlands of White Ponds and Tween Town Woods.

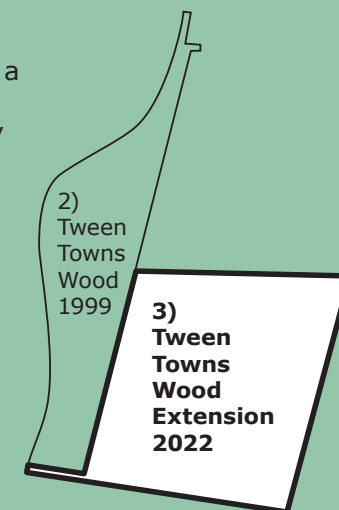

Catalytic Converter Thefts

Additional patrols are in place across Cambridge and South Cambridgeshire following a spate of catalytic converter thefts.

In the last few days, catalytic converters have been stolen from vehicles parked at the Trumpington Park and Ride site, Broad Street and Carl Zeiss in Cambourne, Suez Road in Cambridge and Station Road in Whittlesford.

Action Fraud - has received 752 reports in four days relating to fake emails purporting to be from Ofgem. The emails state that the recipient is eligible for a rebate as a result of a newly announced government scheme. The links in the emails lead to genuine-looking websites that are designed to steal your personal and financial information.

Remember, your bank, or any other official organisation, won't ask you to share personal information over email or text. If you need to check that it's a genuine message, contact the company using details from their official website or app.
